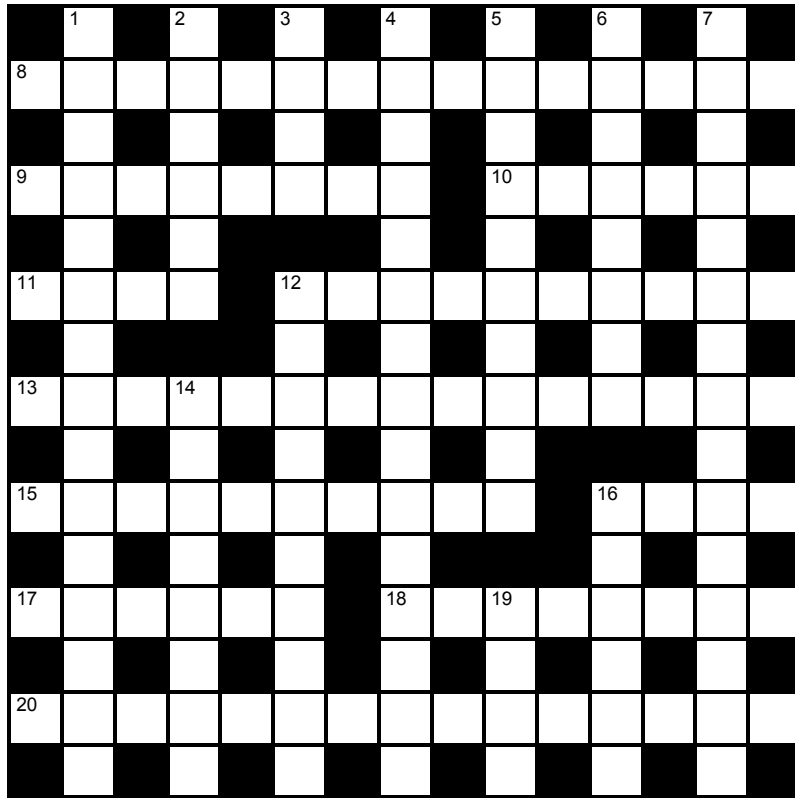


Brighton Puzzle August 2017
