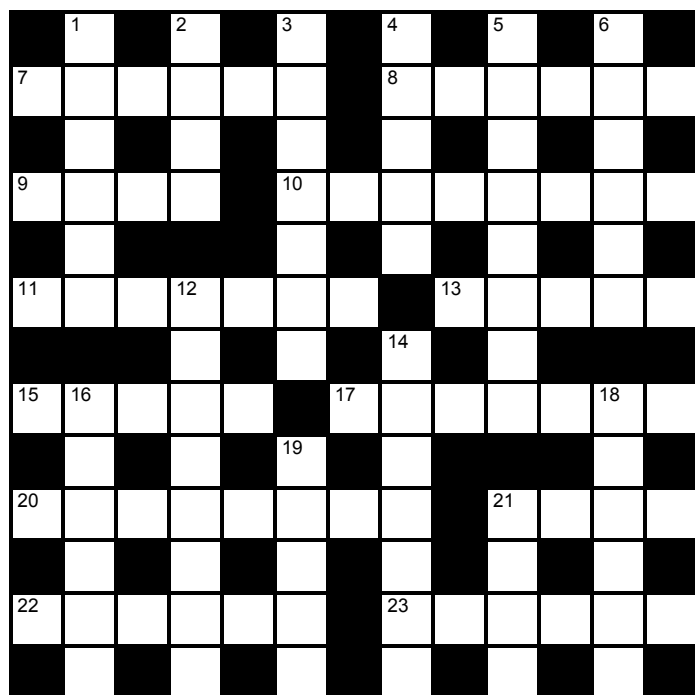


Cryptic Crossword No 238
