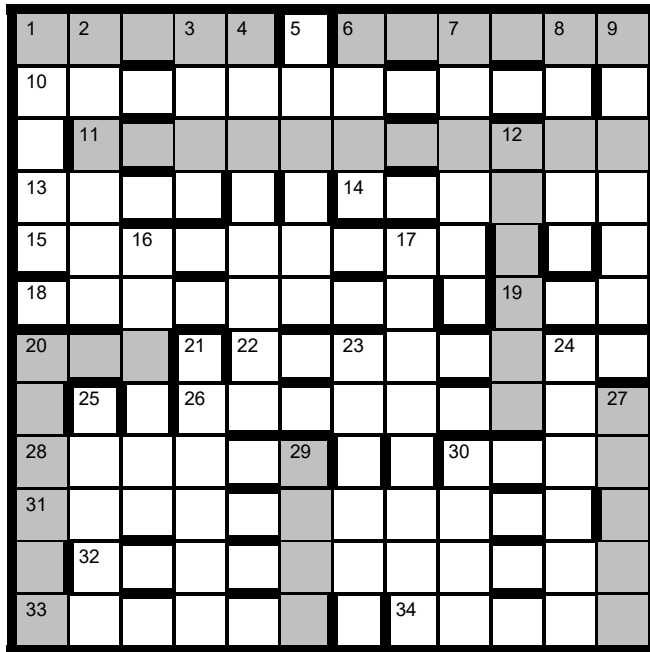


Woolly thinking by Chalicea
