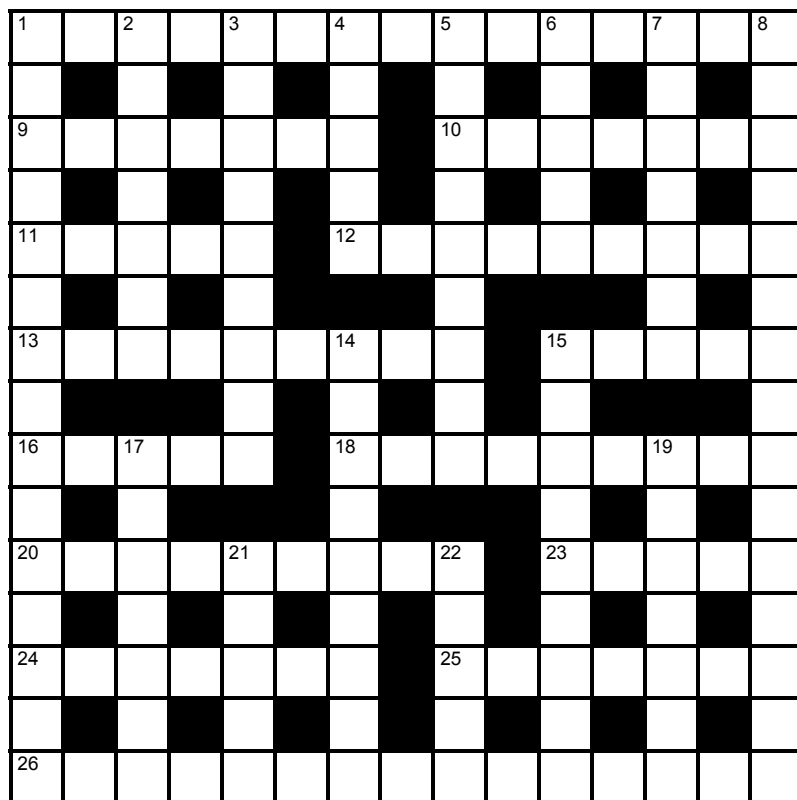


Yet by Pluriserial

In **Yet** there is a misprint in every clue. Correct letters, in clue order, spell out a slightly adapted and truncated quotation. Unclued lights give the author and the last two words. Solvers should highlight a cryptic representation of the title of the work and the name of its hero in the completed grid. One proper name is not in Chambers 2008.

- 1 King of England and Scotland and Ireland; he married the daughter of James II and was invited by opponents of James II to invade England; when James fled (7,2,6)
- 9 Admit (3,2,2)
- 10 Capital of the People's Republic of China in the Hebei province in northeastern China; 2nd largest Chinese city (7)
- 11 Expensive vessel propelled by sail or power and used for cruising or racing (5)
- 12 Any place of complete bliss and delight and peace (7-2)
- 13 Managers of opera companies (9)

Down

- 1 Poisonous perennial Old World vine having violet flowers and oval coral-red berries; widespread weed in North America (5,10)
- 2 Cover used to keep camera eyepiece free of dust when not in use (4,3)
- 3 Genus of plants, several species of which have very beautiful flowers; - so called because the elastic capsules burst when touched, and scatter the seeds with considerable force (9)
- 4 Hypothetical cases that law students argue as an exercise (5)
- 5 Socialism to be established by gradual reforms within the law (9)

- 15** Punished by confinement or by the imposition of a curfew (5)
- 16** Ditches or vertical drops often containing a fence, eg between a garden and surrounding parkland, forming a barrier without interrupting the view (2-3)
- 18** Bell tower; usually standing alone unattached to a building (9)
- 20** Island to the south of the Malay Peninsula (9)
- 23** Lengthening or filling piece to make good a deficiency in length (5)
- 24** Iranian language spoken in Pakistan (7)
- 25** Expand or complete (a part in a piece of baroque music) by supplying the harmonies indicated in the figured bass (7)
- 26** United States film actress (born in England) who was a childhood star; as an adult she often co-starred with Richard Burton (born in 1932) (9,6)
- 6** Feeling remorse for something (5)
- 7** Excessively trusting (7)
- 8** Like a great lord (2,5,8)
- 14** One retired from society for religious reasons (9)
- 15** Republic in Central America; achieved independence from Spain in 1821; noted for low per capita income and illiteracy; politically unstable (9)
- 17** City located 160 km northeast of Hanoi in Vietnam. Capital city of Quang Ninh Province (4,3)
- 19** Occurring at the beginning (7)
- 21** Small terrestrial lizard of warm regions of the Old World (5)
- 22** 3rd planet from the sun (5)
