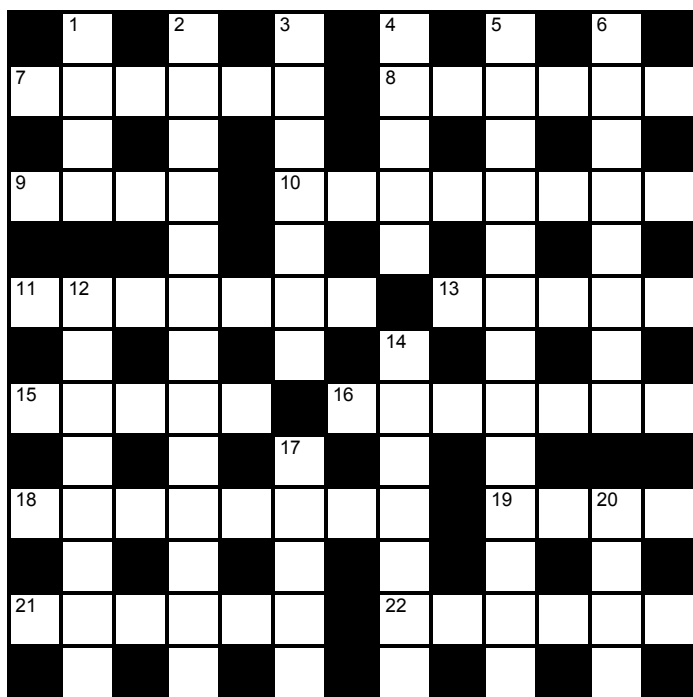


Yet by Pluriserial

Solvers should highlight a cryptic representation of the title of the work and the name of its hero in the completed grid. One proper name is not in Chambers 2008.
