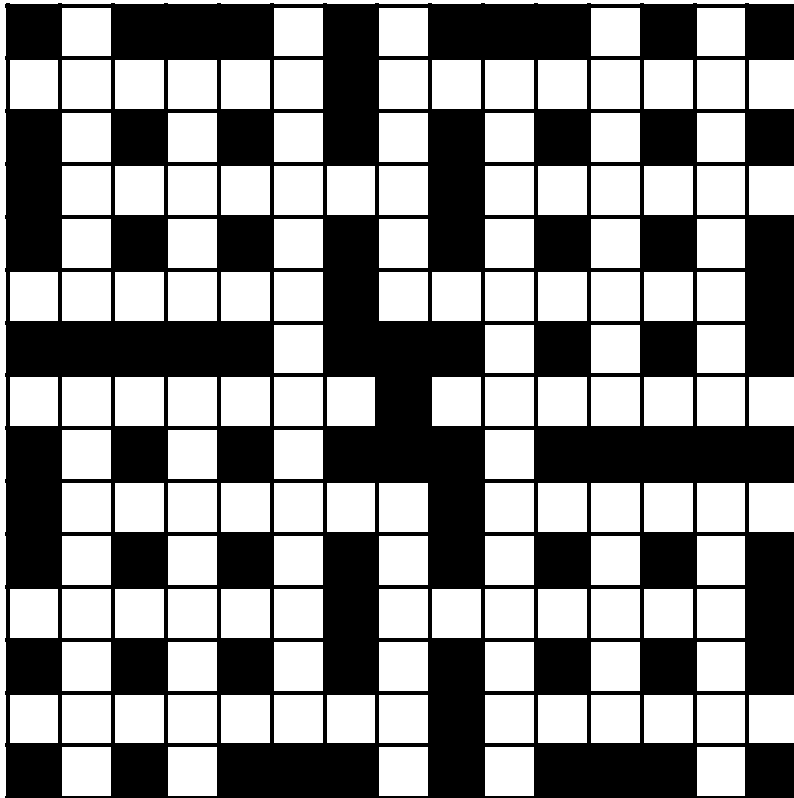


Alphabetical Cryptic Crossword
