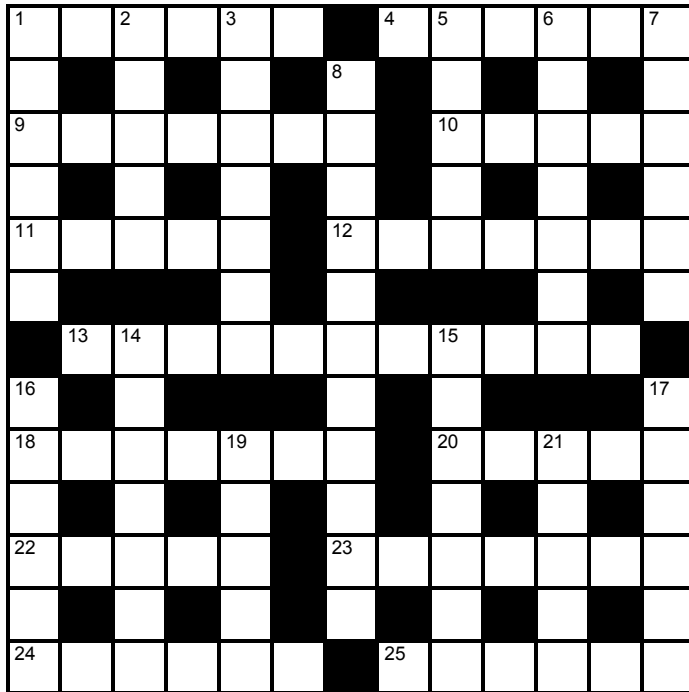


Yet by Pluriserial
