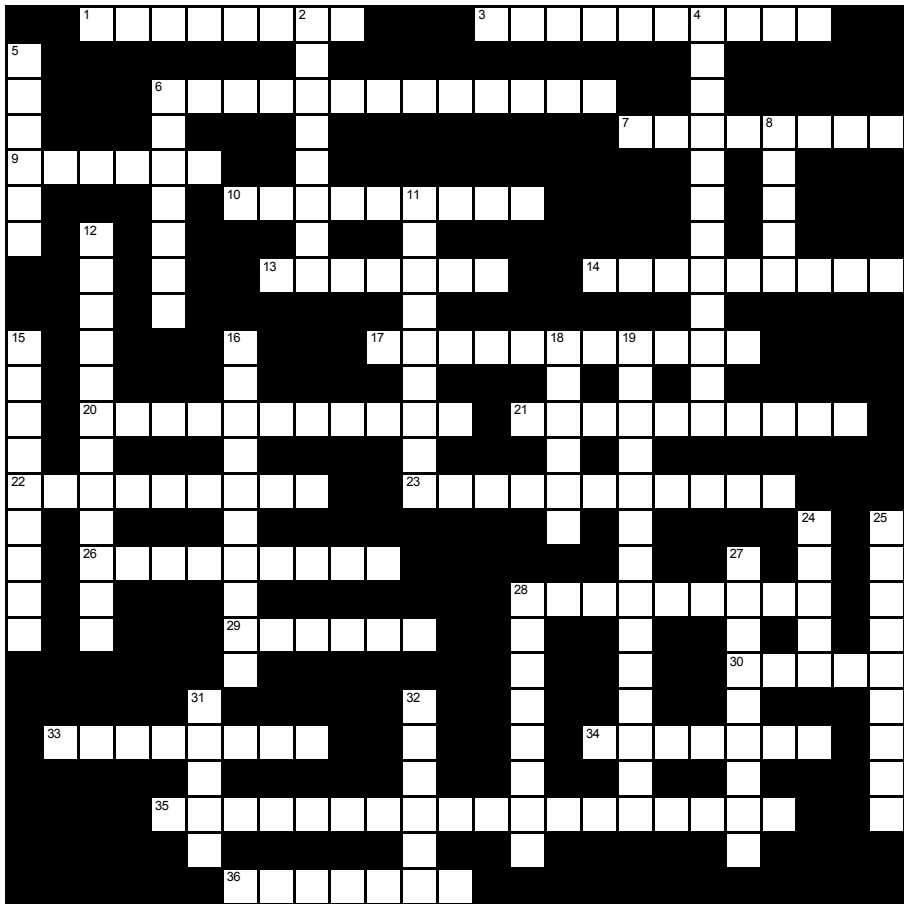

- 11 First used by Germany at Second Battle of Ypres (1915) (6,3)
