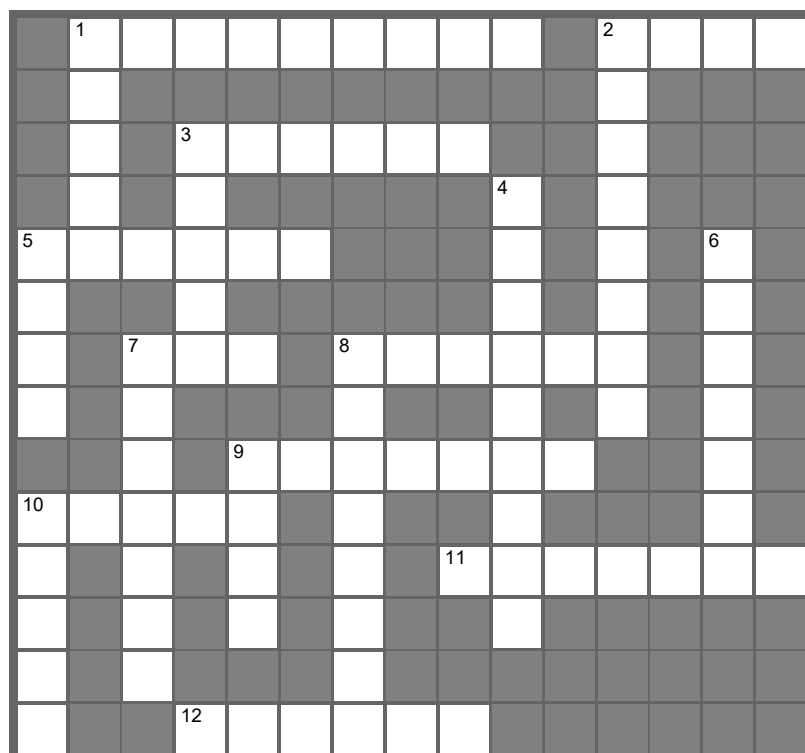


English Worx – Vocabulary – letter B
