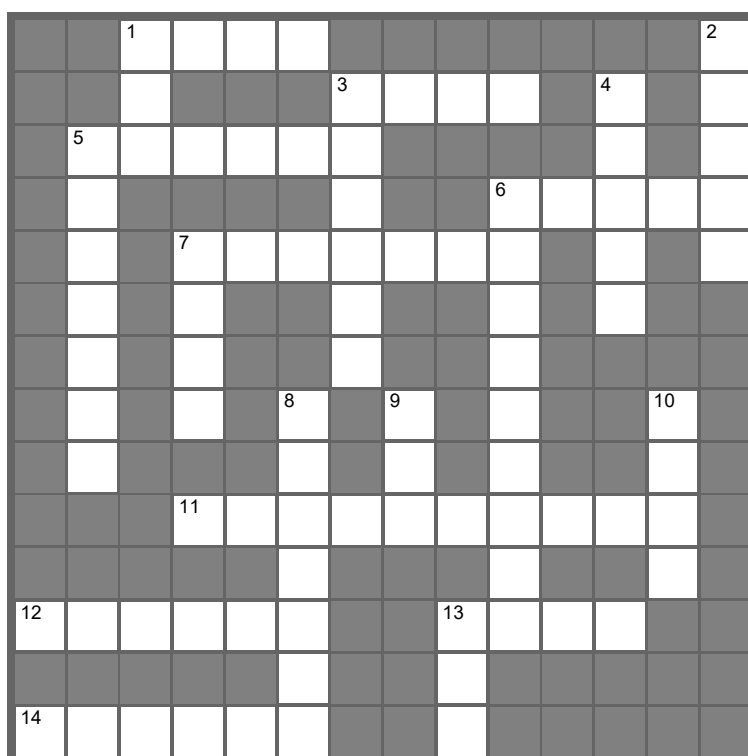


English Worx – Vocabulary – letter XZ
