- 1** 1977 war film directed by Richard Attenborough about the Arnhem operation (1,6,3,3)
- 3** 1978 Lou Adler film starring Cheech & Chong (2,2,5)

- 5** 1971 musical starring Topol (7,2,3,4)
- 7** Disaster movie of 1970 starring Burt Lancaster and Dean Martin - based on an Arthur Hailey novel (7)
- 9** 1973 Supernatural horror film

- 12** Directed by Warren Beatty, this 1978 fantasy-comedy starred him as well as Julie Christie and James Mason (6,3,4)

- 16** Burt Reynolds, Jan-Michael Vincent and Sally Field featured in this 1978 Action comedy (6)

- 17** 1975 blockbuster with Roy Schneider and Richard Dreyfuss, directed by Steven Spielberg (4)
- 18** Second movie in the boxing drama with Sylvester Stallone (5,2)
- 20** Woody Allen film from 1977 featuring himself with Diane Keaton (5,4)
- 21** 1979 supernatural film with James Brolin, Margot Kidder and Rod Steiger (3,10,6)
- 23** Western made in 1971 written, directed and produced by Tom Laughlin - who also starred in it (5,4)
- 24** 1972 Disaster movie set on a sinking cruise liner (3,8,9)
- 25** Another disaster film, this time set in a burning skyscraper (1972) (3,8,7)
- 26** 1978 British film in which Peter Sellers reprised his role as Inspector Clouseau (7,2,3,4,7)

- 2** 1973 coming-of-age comedy written and directed George Lucas. Richard Dreyfuss starred, and it became one of the most profitable films of all time. (8,8)
- 4** Yet another disaster movie (yawn). This time it involves Los Angeles being destroyed by the San Andreas Fault giving way. Ava Gardner was in it along with Charlton Heston (1974) (10)
- 6** Thought-provoking legal drama which won 8 Academy Awards. It starred Dustin Hoffman and Meryl Streep in the title roles (6,2,6)
- 8** George Burns and John Denver starred in this 1977 comedy (2,3)
- 10** Action comedy of 1978 starring Clint Eastwood, Sondra Locke and Clyde (5,5,3,3,5)
- 11** 1977 road comedy with Burt Reynolds and Sally Field (6,3,3,6)
- 13** 1979 science-fiction horror film with Sigourney Weaver, which spawned a massive media franchise. (5)
- 14** Tenth in the James Bond series, this one starred Roger Moore as Bond. "Nobody Does It Better" was the theme song, performed by Carly Simon (3,3,3,5,2)
- 15** Probably best remembered for the white suit and the Bee Gees music, this 1977 dance drama began John Travolta's success (8,5,5)
- 19** Following 14 down, this was the 11th Bond movie (9)
- 21** 1979 underwater movie starring Nick Nolte, Robert Shaw and Jacqueline Bisset (3,4)
- 22** Caper movie set in 1930's Chicago starring Paul Newman and Robert Redford. The film is famous for having Scott Joplin's "The Entertainer"
