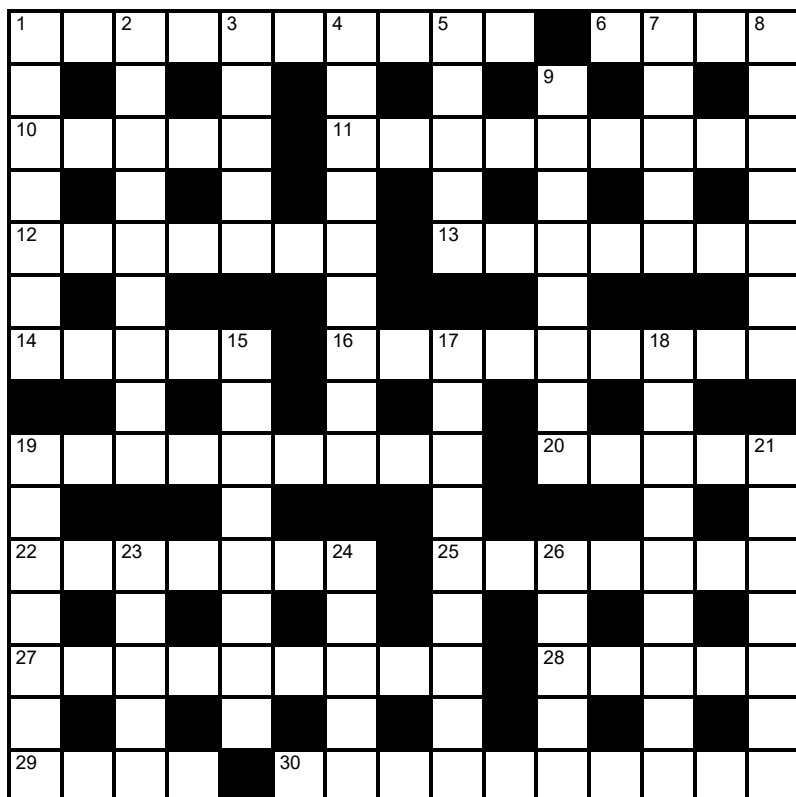


Puzzle 8
