But beware, the ten 'exchange' solutions can also be written in a string (alternating between grids) in which all neighbours are related, thus solution 1 relates to solution 2, but solution 2 relates to both 1 & 3 and so on. You might need Exodus or Uriah Heep to understand 2 & 3.
