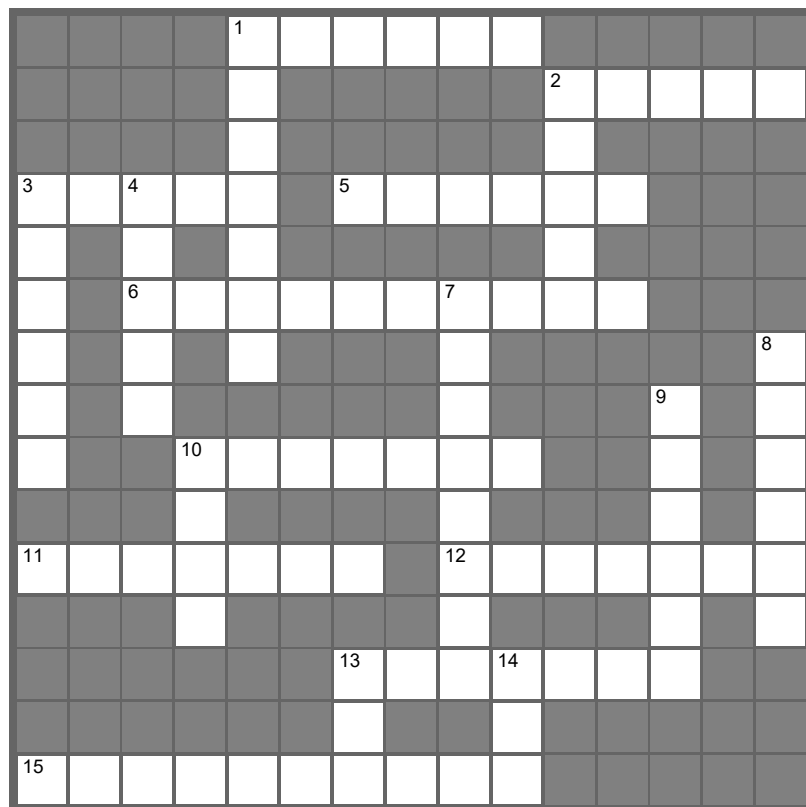


## English Worx – Vocabulary – letter A
