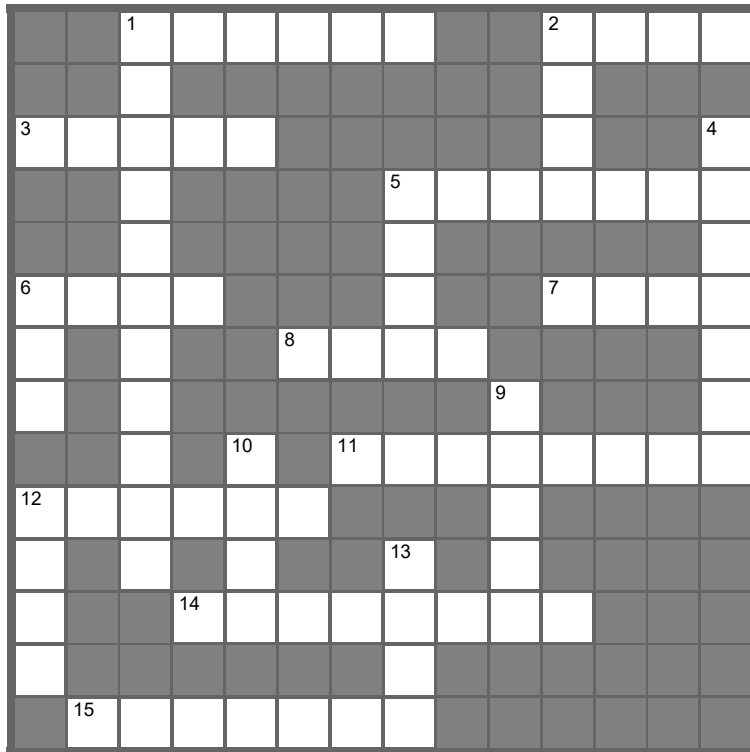


English Worx – Vocabulary – letter M
