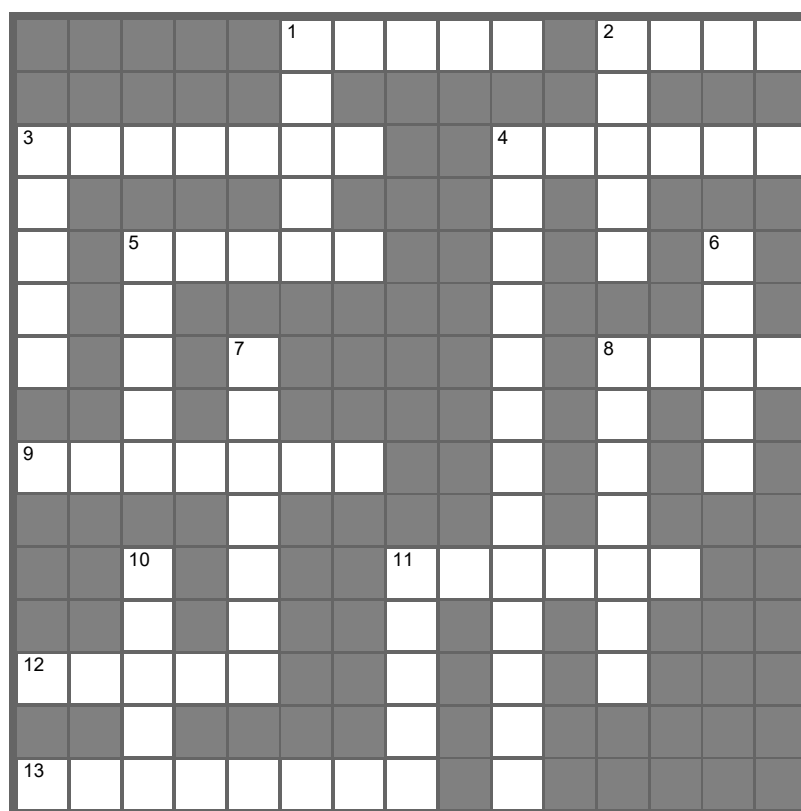


English Worx – Vocabulary – letter Q
