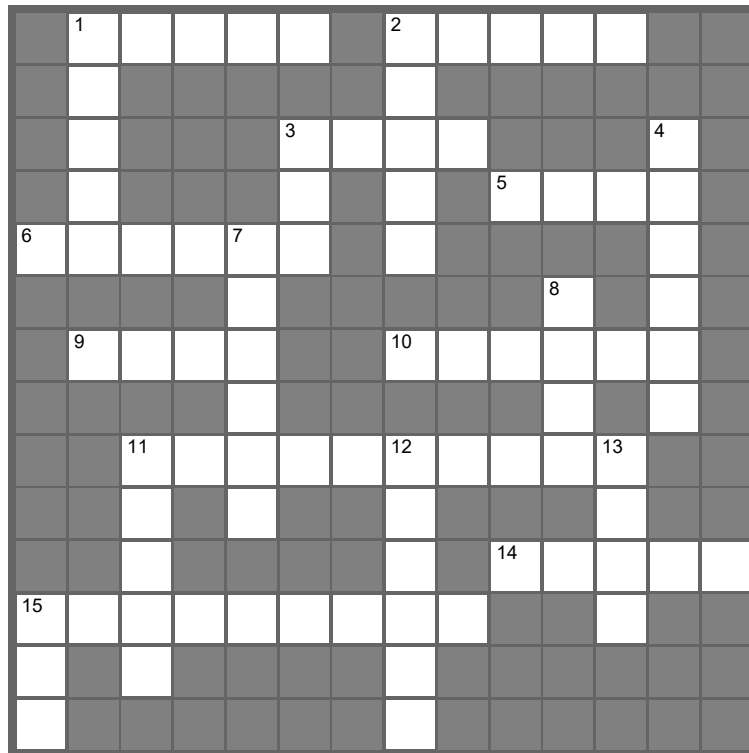


English Worx – Vocabulary – letter R
