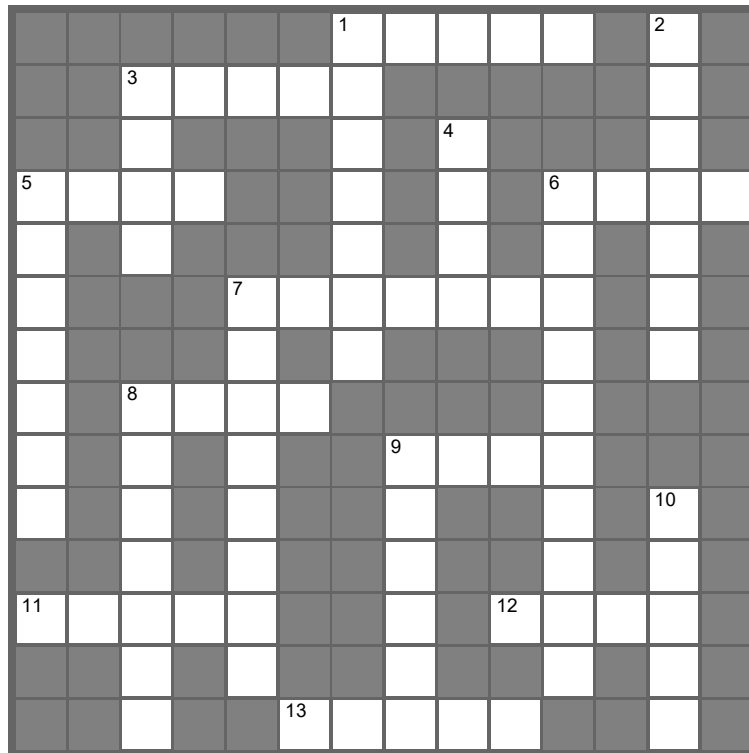


English Worx – Vocabulary – letter W
