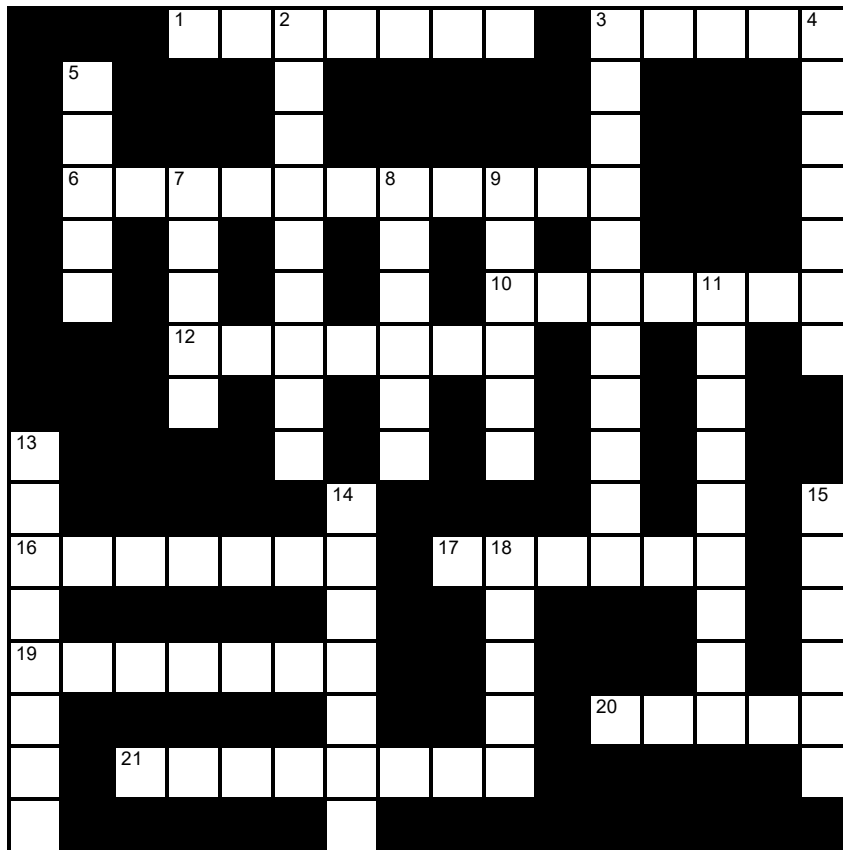


## English Worx
