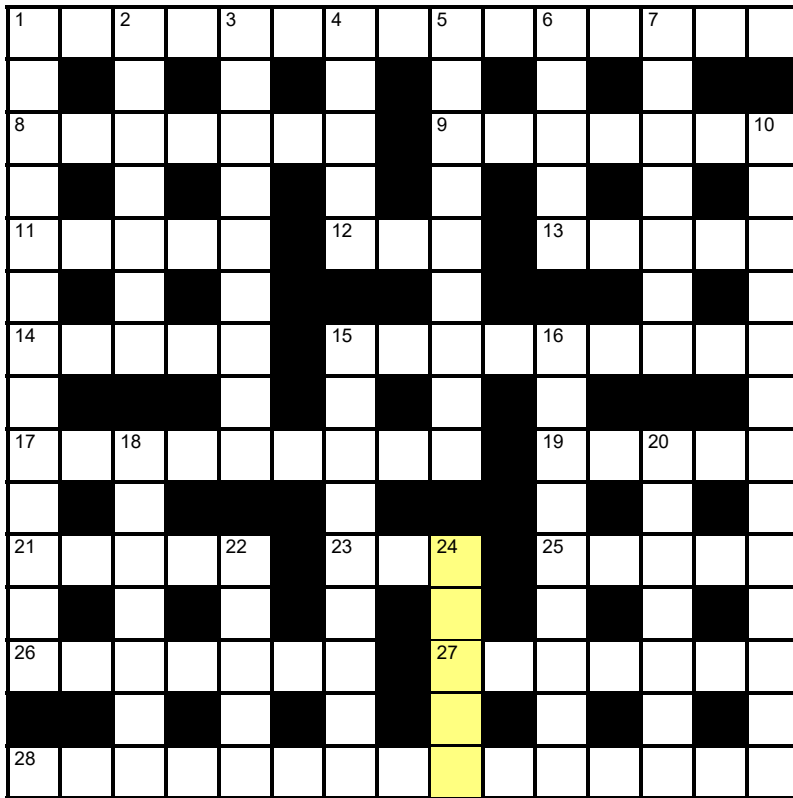


Mark's Crossword
