- 7 1988 romantic comedy starring Tom Cruise which, despite earning a Golden Raspberry Award for Worst Picture, was a huge box office success (8)
- 8 Dustin Hoffman starred as cross-dressing actor in this 1982 romantic comedy (7)
- 9 1986 action film with Tom Cruise, Val Kilmer and Kelly McGillis (3,3)
- 10 Anti-war film based on Director Oliver Stone's experiences in Vietnam, starring Tom Berenger, William Dafoe and Charlie Sheen (1986) (7)
- 15 Tom Selleck, Steve Guttenberg, and Ted Danson starred in this 1987 American comedy about mistaken fatherhood (5,3,3,1,4)

- 18 British caper comedy with John Cleese and Jamie Lee Curtis, in which Michael Palin was hung upside down outside a window (1,4,6,5)
- 20 1989 sci-fi comedy about an inventor (played by Rick Moranis) and his electromagneticshrinking machine (5,1,6,3,4)
- 22 Drama about an inspirational English teacher (Robin Williams) and his students in 1959 America (4,5,7)
- 24 Set in 1965 Vietnam, Robin Williams starred in this irreverent comedy-drama as a Forces Radio DJ (4,7,7)
- 25 Thoughtful drama from 1988 about a wheeler-dealer (Tom Cruise) and his autistic brother Raymond (Dustin Hoffman) (4,3)
- 26 Henry Fonda and Kathryn Hepburn both won Oscars for their performances in this 1981 family drama (2,6,4)

- 2 Richard Gere and Debra Winger romantic drama about a young officer candidate (2,7,3,1,9)
- 3 1984 American comedy-

- 4 American superhero film directed by Tim Burton with Michael Keaton in the title role (6)
- 8 Based on a TV comedy, this was the first of a series of hit comedies for Leslie Nielsen (3,5,3)
- 11 1983 Family comedy drama starring Debra Winger, Shirley MacLaine, Jack Nicholson and Danny DeVito covering 30 years of a relationship between a mother and daughter (5,2,10)
- 12 Michael Douglas plays an adulterous lawyer in this 1987 thriller with Glenn Close appearing as his infatuated mistress. The film coined the term "bunny boiler." (5,10)
- 13 Action comedy set in the Australian Outback starring Paul Hogan and Linda Kozlowski, whom Hogan subsequently married (9,6)
- 14 1989 romantic comedy starring John Travolta and Kirsty Alley, featuring a voiceover commentary from an unborn child! (4,4,7)
- 16 Set in an eponymous bar in 1950's Florida, this 1982 teen sex comedy became the highest-grossing comedy of 1982. In the opinion of this compiler, it was also shit. (6)
- 17 Disney animated film loosely based on a Hans Christian Anderson story. (3,6,7)
- 19 1988 comedy about the unlikely association of Arnold Schwarzenegger and Danny DeVito (5)
- 21 Jane Fonda, Lily Tomlin, and Dolly Parton starred in this 1980 comedy about three working women overthrowing their autocratic boss. (1,2,1)
- 22 First of a seemingly endless series of films astarring Bruce Willis as an NYPD detective. Ironically, this, and others in the series are considered to be Christmas films. (3,4)
- 23 1988 comedy fantasy with Tom Hanks. Later made into a Broadway musical (3)
