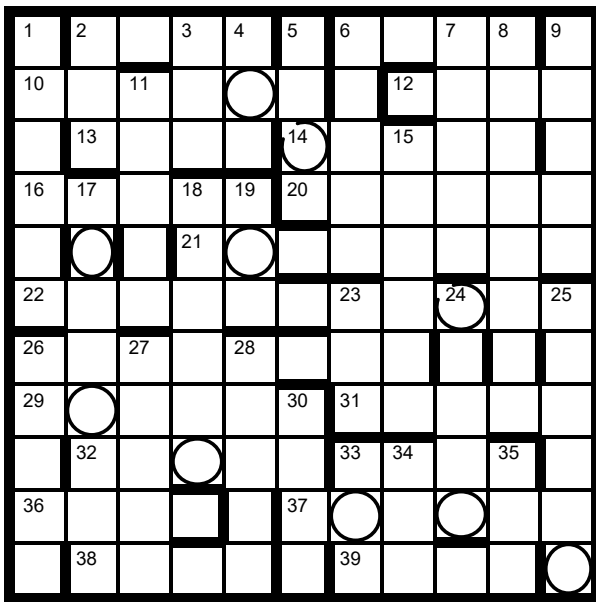


The Sun Junior Coffee-Time Easy Clues by Skirwingle
