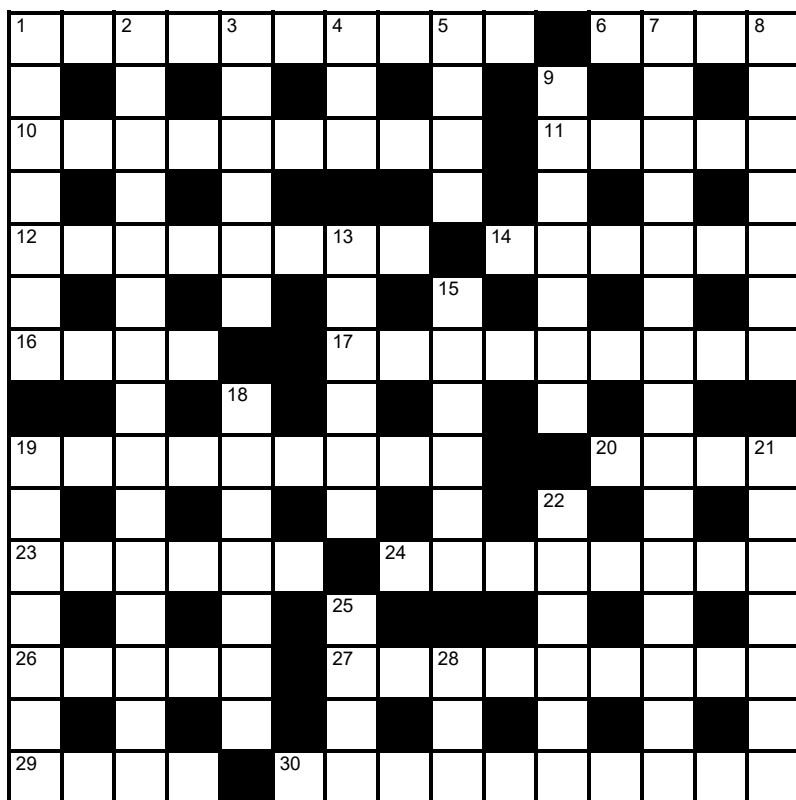


## Puzzle #17
